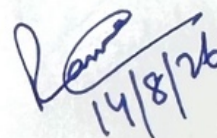
Sir/ Madam,

This is with reference to your application on the subject cited above, the undersigned is directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi vide U.O. No.1507/DE dated 05.08.2026 for Grant of Provisional Upgradation in r/o Bud's Paradise School (School ID: 1207233), St. No. 25, Pusta Road Sant Nagar, Burari from Secondary Level to Sr. Secondary Level (Arts and Commerce) w.e.f 01/04/2026 to 31.03.2031, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) Final outcome of the notification of MoUD, Govt. of India
- 2) That the school shall abide by the provisions of DSEAR, 1973, RTE Act 2009 and the Delhi Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 and directions/instructions issued by the Department from time to time.
- (3) That the school shall comply with the orders dated 07.11.2017/guidelines of DoE and judicial pronouncements w.r.t safety of the students and shall take all necessary steps to this effect.
- (4) That the school shall comply with the provisions of Section 10 (1) read with Rule 125 of DSEAR 1973.
- (5) That the school shall comply with clause 14 of order No.F.DE/15(56)/ACT/2009778 dated 11.02.2009 in r/o maintenance of DRF. School also ensure to follow FN-21 "Accounting by schools" as issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) for proper accounting treatment.


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- (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
- (iii) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
- (iv) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under the Delhi RTE rule 22.
- (v) Inclusion of students with disabilities/special needs as per provision of the Act.
- (vi) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under section 23(1) of the Act Provided further that the current teachers who do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire minimum qualifications within a period of 5 years.
- (vii) The teacher performs its duties specified under section 24 (1) of the Act.
- (viii) The teachers shall not engage himself or herself for private teaching activities.
- (16) The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
- (17) That the school shall follow the three-language formula for teaching.
- (18) That the school shall submit the latest land status report regarding the land mentioned in the lease deed and on which the school has been running.
- (19) The school shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 9 of the RTE Act, 2009.
- (20) No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of the school.
- (21) The school buildings or other structures or the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development.
- (22) The school is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860 (21 of 1860), or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force.
- (23) The school is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons.
- (24) The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper account statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy of each


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of the Statements of Accounts should be sent to the office of Deputy Director of Education (Zone concerned) every year.

(25) The school furnishes its reports and information as may be required by the Director (Education)/Dy. Director of Education (District concerned) from time to time and complies with such instructions of the Appropriate Government/Local Authority as may be issued to secure the continues fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.

(26) That the school shall comply with the order/guidelines of DoE and judicial pronouncement w.r.t utilization/maintenance of school funds.

(27) That the school shall submit the police clearance certificate of the teaching & non-teaching staff of the school to the District Authority within 30 days.

(28) That the school shall submit the latest FDR account details of the school to the DDE(District) within one month.

(29) Renewal of Registration of Society if any, be ensured.
